All orders for Christmas dinner must be pre-ordered by Friday, December 5th. Parents are welcome to join their child for our Christmas dinner. Please pre-order.

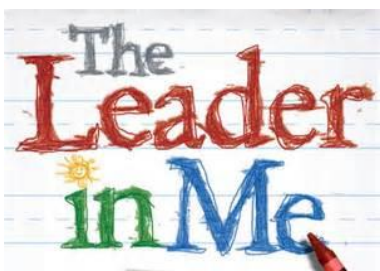
If you can volunteer to help please call Stacey at 352-5555

The student leadership group has decided to fundraise for the Miramichi SPCA.

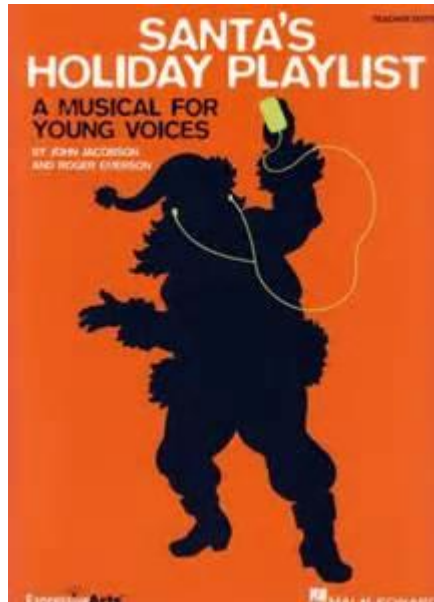
Every Friday till Christmas, will be our dress up theme days. Students and staff are asked to pay \$1.00 to dress up for the day. Our themes are as follow.
