



COLD WEATHER:

On most days during the winter, children will be going outside at noon. Parents are reminded to dress children for the weather including winter coats, hats, mittens and ski pants. If it is too wet or the wind chill is below -15 degrees Celsius, however, staff may opt to keep children inside on these days.
