HALLOWEEN SPOOKTACULAR

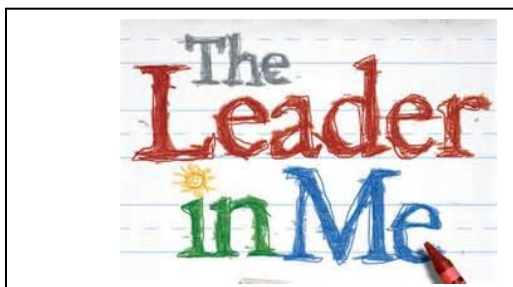
